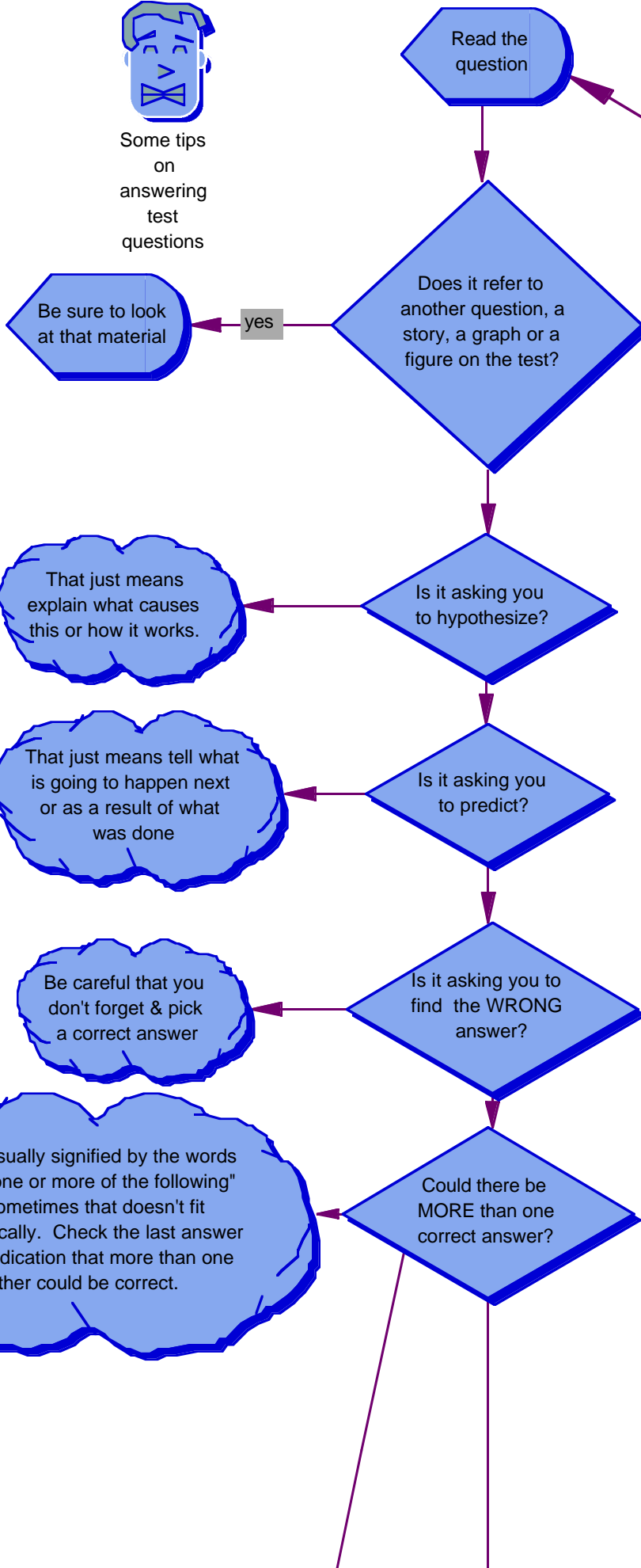

Be sure to look at that material

Does it refer to another question, a story, a graph or a figure on the test?

That just means explain what causes this or how it works.

Is it asking you to hypothesize?

That just means tell what is going to happen next or as a result of what was done

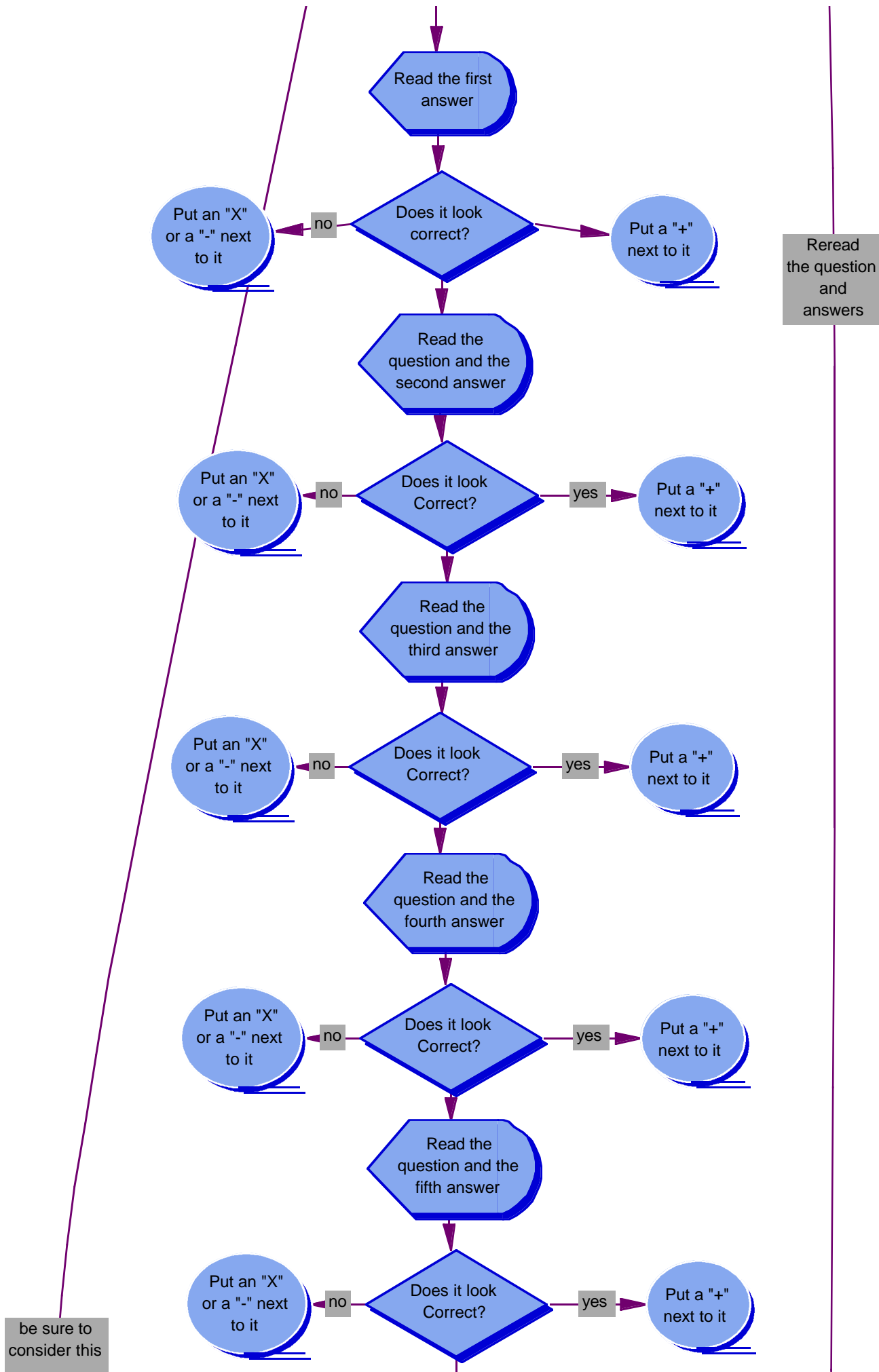
Is it asking you to predict?

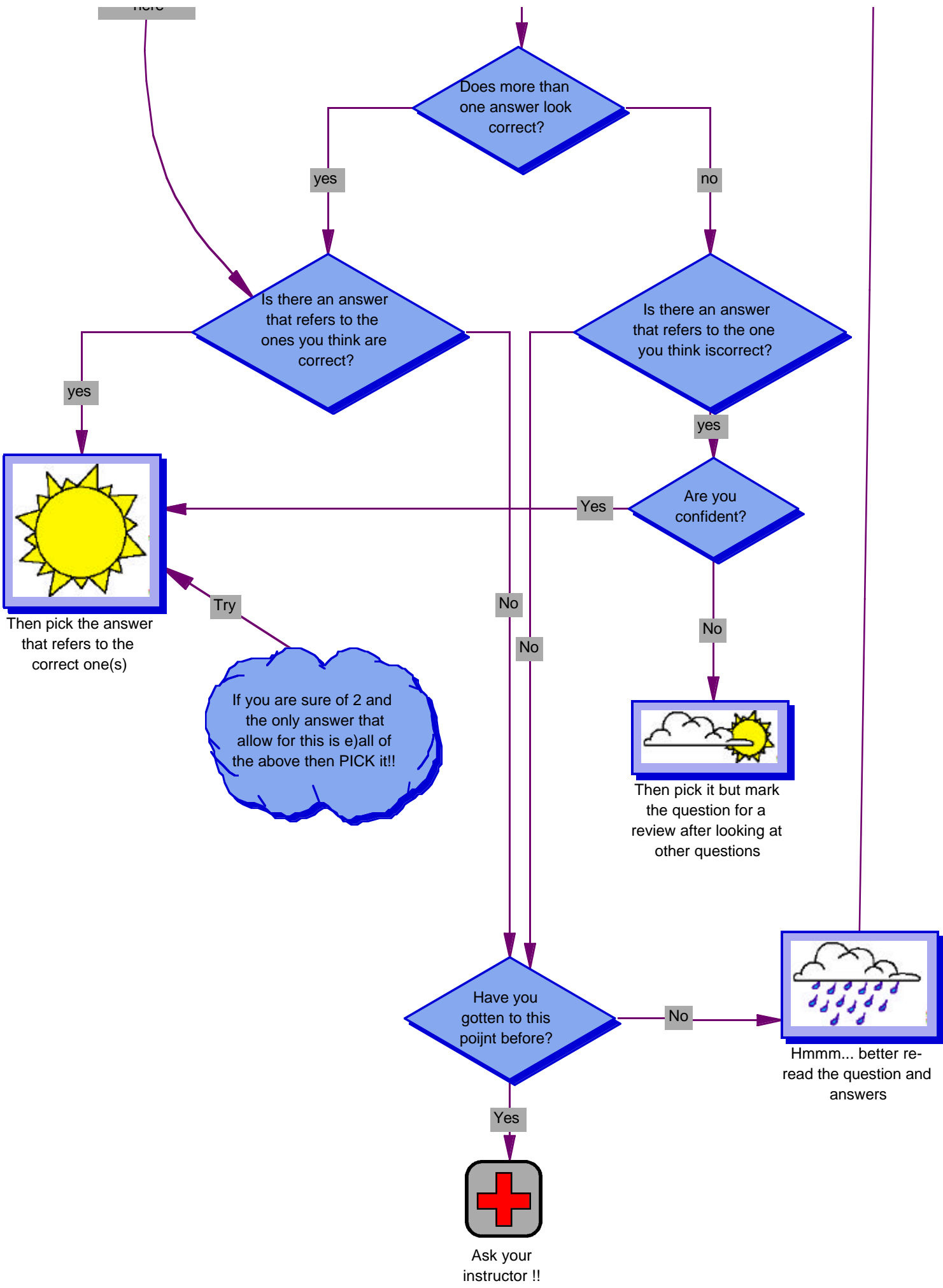
Be careful that you don't forget & pick a correct answer

Is it asking you to find the WRONG answer?

This is usually signified by the words "which one or more of the following" but sometimes that doesn't fit grammatically. Check the last answer for an indication that more than one other could be correct.

Could there be MORE than one correct answer?





Does more than one answer look correct?

Is there an answer that refers to the ones you think are correct?
